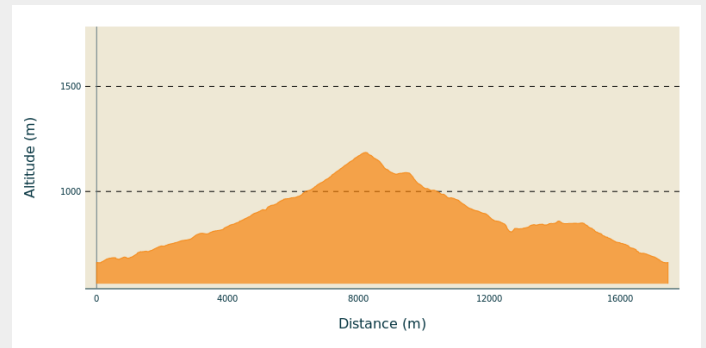

## Altimetric profile



Min elevation 661 m Max elevation 1186 m

Starting at the intersection of the main trail and the road, cross the bridge over the “Rif.” Head toward Montagne de Chabre for about 7 km (you can take a detour to the summit to enjoy a 360° view before beginning the descent). Before reaching the summit, take a small trail on the right through the woods. The trail winds through the scrubland and overlooks the Méouge and Buëch valleys before rejoining the trail. Caution! Just after passing the ONF gate, the trail turns, while the path you need to take goes straight ahead into a meadow (it is barely visible). Follow the path and cross the trail to continue on the trail before rejoining a trail. Continue on this trail for over 2 km before beginning a descent on a trail to the left. The trail runs alongside the ruins of Vieux Villard, then joins a final trail after a few hairpin turns.
